Metro Passes

Metro Monthly and 30-Day Passes are valid for unlimited rides during their month of issue. All Zone Monthly Passes are good throughout the system. Single Zone Monthly Passes are good only in the zone on the face of the pass. For example: Riders with Zone 1 passes pay a 30 cent charge debarking in Zone 2. Riders with Zone 1 passes boarding in Zone 2 pay full fare (\$1.75).

30 Day Passes are valid for 30 days from the date of purchase and available only at Metro vending machines.

Day Passes are valid on the service day of purchase (5 a.m. to 2 a.m.) and available at Metro ticket vending machines or from your bus operator.

Weekend Passes are valid on the weekend of purchase, 12 a.m. Saturday through the end of Sunday service, and available at Metro ticket vending machines or from your bus operator.

Monthly Passes are valid for one calendar month. They can be purchased at participating Dash's, Martin's, Tops, Wilson Farms and the MTC (bus station, downtown Buffalo.)

ZONES - TRANSFERS - TOKENS

The Metro system is divided into four fare zones, with a 30 cent full fare (15 cent reduced fare) charge each time you cross into a new zone. Zones are marked on route maps appearing on every schedule.

On inbound trips crossing more than one zone, the entire fare is paid when boarding. On outbound trips, zone charges are paid when leaving the bus.

Transfers, available from your bus operator, allow you to board a connecting bus. Transfers are 35 cents full fare (15 cents reduced) and are paid when boarding the second bus.

Tokens are worth \$1.75, but cost \$1.60 when purchased in quantities of 10 or more. Tokens can be purchased at many area banks.

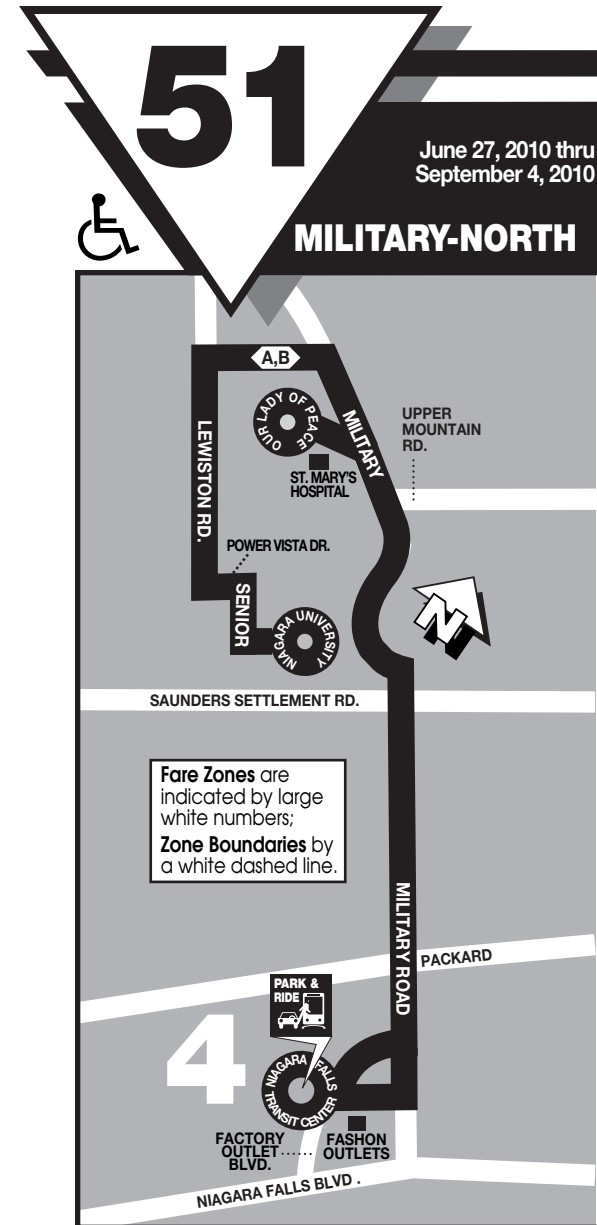
Metro fareboxes accept Metro tokens, U.S. coins, paper money and Metro passes. Remember, bus and trolley operators do not make change.

Please have your fare ready when boarding.

*Reduced fares are available for children five to 11 years old, Seniors (65 and older), disabled and Medicare with proper ID. Children four and under ride free with an adult, limit three children per fare paying adult.

To qualify for reduced fares, passengers must present approved ID: Erie/Niagara County Complimentary Card, Metro Half-Fare Card or Medicare Card. Present when boarding your bus or when requested on Metro Rail.
