Note: Entire round trip fare is paid when boarding bus at N. Division & Ellicott. Upon paying fare, a return pass card will be issued and is required to board bus on return trip. Passengers boarding bus at Darien Lake without a return pass card will be required to pay \$5.00

TRANSFERS & PASSES

No Metro transfers or Metro passes will be accepted or issued on Route #97 Darien Lake.

*SENIOR CITIZENS & DISABLED

Passengers must present approved identification - Erie/Niagara County Complimentary Card, Metro Reduced Fare Card, or Medicare Card when boarding the bus and when requested on Metro Rail to qualify for reduced fare. Wheelchair passengers will pay regular reduced fare rates on bus and rail except when required to board at the rear door of a bus.
